Built on the side of the mountain, with preferential access to the slopes of the world’s largest skiable area, each chalet is a warm and elegant haven that can sleep up to 12 people. Each space has been carefully designed, down to the very finest detail.

Over 5 floors, each fully equipped with the latest in home technology, the chalets enjoy spacious, welcoming bedrooms and large terraces or balconies to make the most of the snowy panorama. There are, naturally, spaces dedicated to relaxation: pools, spas, home cinemas, billiards, library, a lounge and a bar. The Nanuq also has a mezzanine floor with a dedicated children’s area.

This peak experience is sublimated by the tailor-made services offered by the Evok Hôtels Collection group. Like the finest hotels and palaces that this iconic ski resort boasts, these chalets can also organise a concierge service, a butler, chef, sports coach or a babysitting service.
